



Restricted Member Contact Information Policy

Background

In October 2010 during the initial BPNA formation meeting, many members requested the BPNA restrict the use of their personal contact information to BPNA related business. Several members said they regarded their contact information as private and for their personal use only.

Policy

BPNA member contact information will not be made available or distributed to anyone other than those members "that need to know" for the purpose of conducting BPNA related business.

Restricted contact information includes, but is not limited to, any information that a member might consider personal or private, i.e. member name(s) and address, telephone or cell numbers, email, etc.

Any member contact information made available on the BPNA website will only be posted with the prior approval of the member.

Exceptions

BPNA committee chair email addresses and officer contact information as required by Texas state law with respect to Domestic Nonprofit Corporation requirements.
